Our mission is to deliver specialist treatment for veterans with complex mental health needs, whilst supporting their families and network, to help them tackle the past and take on their future.

Why support Combat Stress:

- We deliver life-changing treatment, bringing together professionals with a specialist focus to meet individual needs. Giving veterans the tools to manage their mental health and helping them on their journey to recovery - it's a service that thousands depend on. No one else does what we do.
- We are experts in treating the impact of military trauma.
- Veterans with complex mental health conditions need a specialist team made up of different mental health professionals to help them and we provide this. Our clinicians work closely with each other to make a treatment plan for each veteran that is unique to them.





What your support helps us achieve - Stats your audience might like to know:

- Follow stats from 2023 2024:
- Almost 12,500 veterans benefited from our direct support
- 8,241 called our helpline
- 2,748 veterans accessed our newly developed online self-help resources
- 1,486 veterans directly received support from our specialist staff
- We have supported veterans from 15 different conflicts
- 2,000 family members have benefited from our specialist support

What donations mean to us:

- £4 could provide art materials for a veteran to create artwork at home as part of their treatment, offering a way to express emotions and promote self-awareness.
- £24 could pay for a veteran to attend a group Peer Support meeting to receive support and understanding from others who've walked a similar path.
- £58 could allow veterans family members to use our Family Support Service to help them understand mental health symptoms, the treatment Combat Stress is providing and how to help the veteran in their family.
- £82 could fund a 1:1 session for a veteran with a mental health nurse to help them with a range of different issues including drinks and drugs use, PTSD symptoms, anger management and sleep hygiene.
- £179 could fund a specialist psychological assessement for a veteran who is experiencing particularly complex mental health difficulties to understand how we can support them to recovery.
